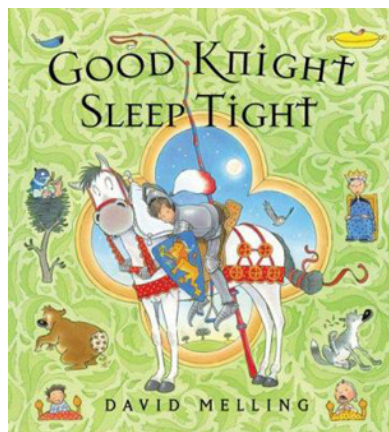

A story of love and humour about a new, sobbing sibling, and what to do about it...

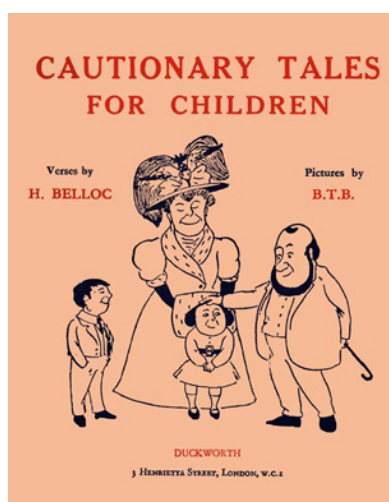


The Snail and the Whale

A heart-warming tale of friendship and adventure.

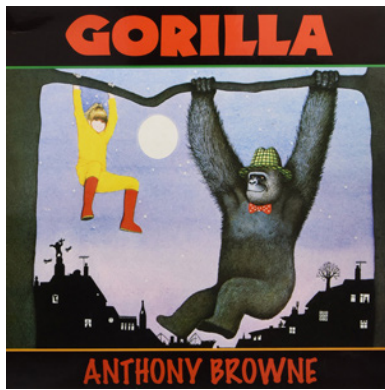


Jim – who ran away from his Nurse and was eaten by a Lion

And there are many more uproarious admonitions for mischievous children.

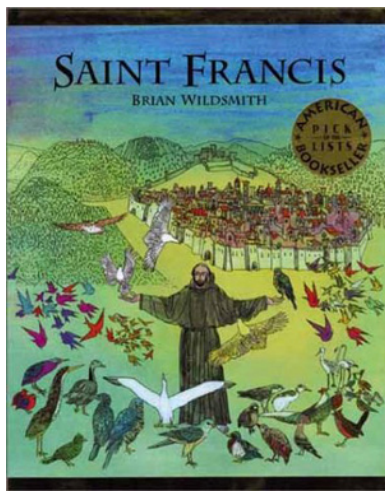


Gorilla
