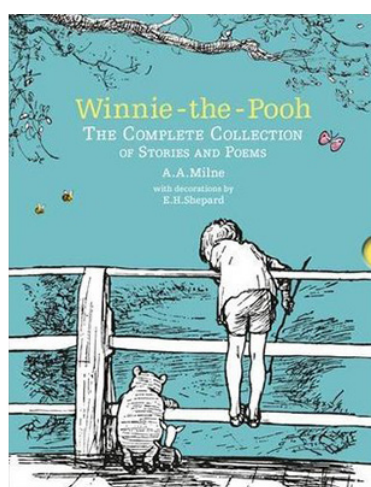
How to read with boys age 4 – 8

Tip 1 – Daily commitment

Nothing releases a boy's potential like routine. Make time to read to, and with, your son every day.

Tip 2 – What's the book about?

Before you start a book, ask your son some simple questions. What's on the cover? What does the title suggest? What do the pictures show? And what might they mean?



Tip 3 – Read in different voices

Try different voices for different characters. And ask your son to join in the common bits: *'Then I'll huff, and I'll puff, and I'll blow your house down!'* or *'We can't go over it. We can't go under it. Oh no! We've got to go through it!'*
